

Nerrols to Bathpool

This section is again more of a winter section when there is a bit of colour in the water.
With a good head of Roach Rudd and Perch.
With an average depth around 3ft
Summer 3 winter 4

ITT Bridge to Nerrols

This section is best fished when there is colour coming in from the river with
Depths of 2.5ft -3ft clear water makes this section fish really hard
Fantastic Roach and Rudd fishing in the winter months.
Summer 2 winter 4

Charlton Orchard

This section is split in two by a bridge.
Upstream towards Taunton is another big fish section with large Tench, Pike and Perch being the fish to target.
Downstream of the bridge is more of a mixed fishery with a good head of Roach Rudd Perch and Tench.
This is probably the deepest section of Canal going to 5ft in places.

Creech St Michael

This section has the biggest carpark with a few options
If you go left you need to go under the road bridge this is much better fishing than before the road bridge. With Rudd and Tench also lots of small pike to 15lb.
The fishing in front of the car park is also very good for Roach and Rudd.
Then there is downstream to the right just past the wires and up to fox hole road bridge.
This stretch is a noted big fish section with Tench Rudd and large perch.
Summer 4 Winter 5*

The Cutt

This section is good when the wind is really strong as it's in a Cut and is sheltered from all sides. This can be a good Perch spot in winter.
Depths of 2.5ft -3ft
Summer 3 Winter 4

Outwood swing Bridge, Lower Greenway to greenway

The start of this section is from the swing bridge at Outwood this leads into the lower Greenway stretch.
In the summer months this section can hold a lot of the very large Rudd to 3lb+ and Tench to 7lb
On to the last section on the TAA ticket at Greenway. This section most known for its Tench to 7lbs+ and its specimen Rudd to just under 4lb also the odd bream, fishing from April through till late October. With match weights over 40lbs in recent years.
This is also a fantastic section for pike with fish going to nearly 20lb.
The depth here is around 3.5ft-4ft. One point of note if the weather is cold and the water is coloured you can have a really hard day on your hands on this section due to its open nature.

Summer 5* winter 3

The Swans Neck

The swan's neck is up stream of the A361 at Durston Road Bridge. This section is probably the most secluded part of the canal with farm land both sides.
The fishing can be really good here with big Tench and quality Roach and Rudd with some large Perch as well.
There are not so many pike in this section. But that's not to say you will not catch one.
With Depths from 3.5ft to 4ft making it one of the deepest sections of the Canal.

Summer 4 winter 4

Bathpool

The start of this section would include the boat moorings at Bathpool down to the A38 Road Bridge.
This is a really good spot for Perch and quality Roach in the winter.
Past the wires towards Creech is a good match section with weights of 6kg to 10kg of Roach possible.

Summer 3 winter 5*

Hyde Lane

This section holds lots of small pike and the odd good Perch. The Roach and Rudd fishing can be good all year around.
