Making it a good summer and winter section of the Tone. With Chub, Bream, Roach and some good Pike and Perch. There is a large weir that holds the water back at the lower end.

This marks the end of TAA water and the start of the free water.

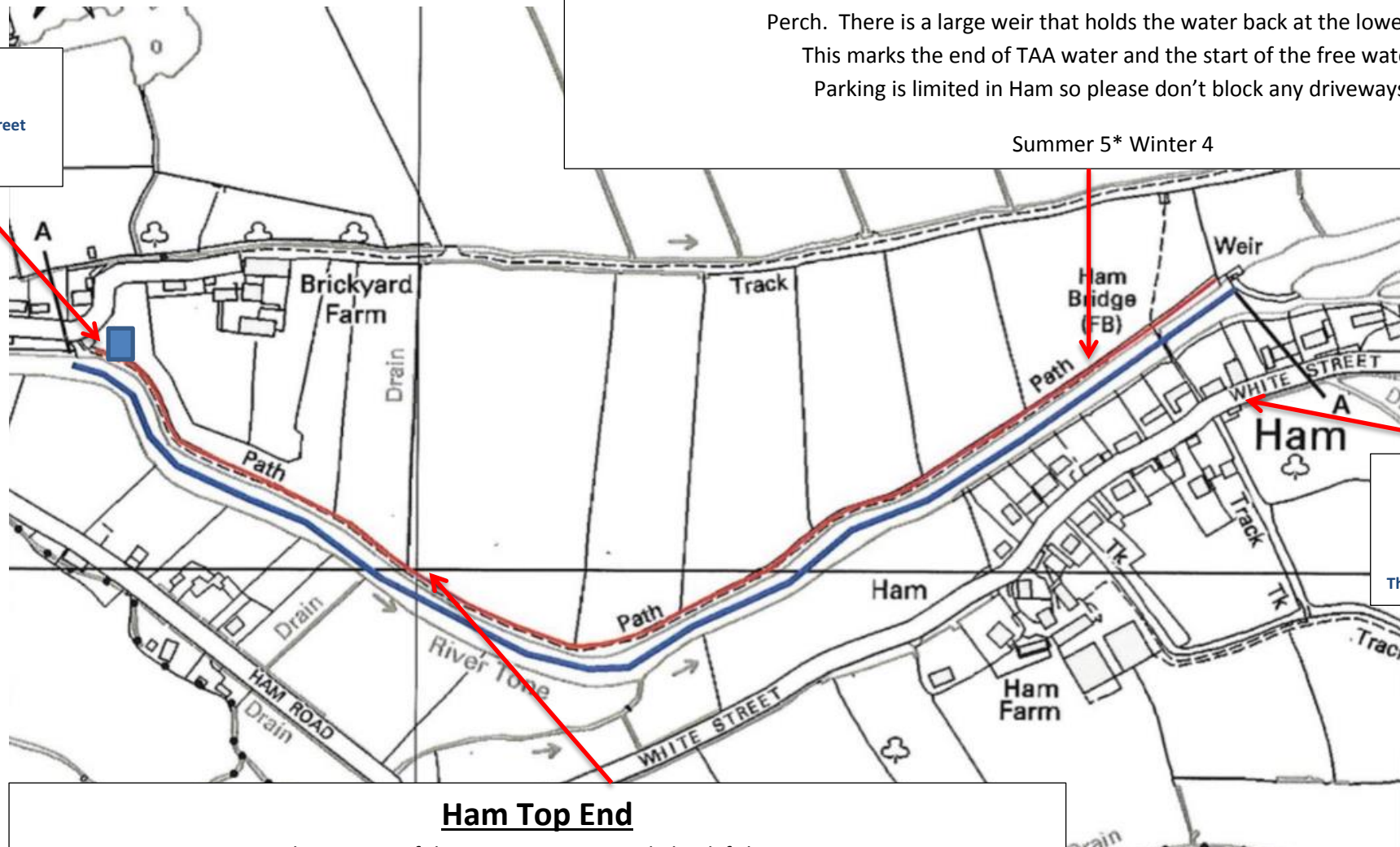
Parking is limited in Ham so please don't block any driveways.

The water here is really deep 12-14ft with very little flow making it ideal for big Bream shoals. There are several big Carp in this section but as with all river Carp they are not the easiest to catch.

The banks can be high off the water in places, making it hard to get down to water level.

The parking from the top end is of down Bull Street just inside the gate next to the boat slip.
